ENGLISH PROFICIENCY PROGRAMME

The programme consists of four terms of ten weeks (nine teaching weeks and one assessment week per term), covering different topics designed to build language skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening, etc.). The programme is intended to lead students from elementary level to an intermediate level of English proficiency (an IELTS minimum score of 5.5).



FOUNDATION

Our Foundation Programme establishes a pathway for students wishing to gain a seamless entry into any of the undergraduate programmes at Lancaster University Ghana. This one-year programme is a requirement for WASSCE, SSCE, GBCE, NECO and equivalent graduates, provided they have the accepted grades. It is also the only programme in Sub-Saharan Africa to have received full accreditation by the British Accreditation Council.

Completion of the Foundation Programme with a minimum completion grade guarantees progression into the first year of all our undergraduate programmes.

SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants must have obtained 4 As and 2Bs or better in 6 subjects in WAEC, and a minimum of 4A's in IGCSE and 2A's in A Levels for direct entry.


2. Financial aid


